## **JULY AND YTD FINANCIALS**

The July income statement and YTD financial performance were reviewed. Because of an elevator issue in Building 3 plus a few other minor issues, there will be no maintenance painting done this year. We are \$6,000 over budget. As such, the deficit will be taken from the reserve fund. This overage will cause a delay in replacing the roof on building 4. Other expenses are within the budget.

#### PENDING PROJECTS DISCUSSIONS

- 1. Have Tom Jones check the circuit breaker for Building 2.
- 2. The door buzzer on Building 2 does not allow for a 2-way conversation. Don will follow up.
- 3. The sewer line in Building 3 has many patches. Tom Jones will check out.
- 4. The bike path bridge needs repaired. Tom Jones will check out.
- 5. Interior identifier numbers for all building will cost around \$800. Kristin Marcucilli is working on a mockup with Indiana Sign. The outside number signage has gotten good reviews.
- 6. Schedule a walk about for K. Marcucilli and Jon Parrish. Stone needs to be laid by Building 1. Edging also not being done. Don will coordinate.
- 7. Possible carpenter ant issue in Buildings 2 & 3. Gayle Burns will contact Rose Exterminators.
- 8. Get an inspector to look at the inside and outside of all buildings. K. Marcucilli will handle.
- 9. Sinking steps on east side of Building 4. The treatment used to raise steps did not work. A1 will make a second visit on September 3.
- 10. Free tree stump removal. K. Marcucilli will investigate.
- 11. Tom Kimbrough and Don Banowetz will personally serve a lien for nonpayment of assessment and condo fees to the offending homeowner.
- 12. Elevators in Buildings 3 & 4 are old. A discussion took place about replacement. Action is pending.

## **OTHER BUSINESS**

- 1. Snow removal quotes. Don to get started.
- 2. 2022 Preliminary Budget. Tom Kimbrough made a motion to approve the budget; Kristin Marcucilli seconded. Motion passed.
- 3. Irrigation system. All agreed that it is completed.
- 4. Fall get together. Event scheduled for the garden area on October 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 5. Building Expansion Discussion. All agreed to send out information early and have a discussion at the Annual Meeting with a vote to follow in 30 days.
- 6. FWCC had trees removed behind Building 2.
